

Westbourne Parish Hall ('Hall')

Rear Field – use for car parking

St John the Baptist Westbourne Parochial Church Council ('PCC')

Conditions of use:

1. The field is only available for car parking if specific arrangements have been made as part of a booking of the Hall or for a service or event in the Church. It is only to be used by persons using the Church or Hall and is not for any form of public parking.
2. The entrance to the field is barred by a steel gate with a combination lock. If the field is available for use, then the lock will be removed but the gate will be kept closed. The PCC appreciates that it is not practical to close the gate after each vehicle enters but when the event in the Hall or the Church has started the gate should be closed to prevent unauthorised access. Similarly, when vehicles are leaving the last person to leave should ensure the gate is closed.
3. The field is to be used sensibly and especially when leaving at night pay due regard to our neighbours and their right to a quiet and peaceful life. Drive carefully and slowly at all times. The entrance is shared with pedestrians.
4. All vehicles parked in the field are parked exclusively at the owner's risk. The PCC accepts no liability for any loss, theft or damage howsoever caused to vehicles.
5. The wooden gates leading from the back of the hall to the field must be kept clear of vehicles at all times.
6. Any hirer should consider whether they need to control car parking. If a large event, parking should be controlled by marshals wearing high visibility vests – which the hirer must provide. Note especially that the entrance to the field is partially obscured and any hirer will be advised to have someone guiding guests in.
7. The field whilst mown is a field and as such not a level area. Care must be taken when walking across it and especially when accessing from the field into the hall via the rear gates.
8. Please make your guests aware of these conditions.
